**OBJECTIVES:** The Conference focuses on philosophy, religion, science and art general relations, and Symposium examines issues of the selected region.

**DEADLINES:** 15. May – early registration (with 25% discount); 31. May – abstract submission; 16. May - 15. June – late registration; 24. June – full paper submission.

**REGISTRATION** is effective if the conference fee of 148 EUR (74 EUR for students) is paid between 16. May and 15. June, or the **reduced by 25 percent rate is paid before 15. of May.**

Registration fee covers the costs of preparing information materials, programme and abstract edition (*Studium Vilnense A vol.14 precursor*), hiring halls, services at coffee/tea breaks and the welcome reception, etc., as well as editing, publishing, cataloguing in Polish and Lithuanian databases, and sending the post-conference proceedings. As is agreed at previous Conferences, a registered participant shall present no more than two personal or co-authored reports.

The registration fee does not include the costs of lunches, conference dinner, and the tour: participants are expected to pay directly for the service providers.

**LANGUAGE:** The language of oral and poster presentations, as well as the language of articles submitted for publishing, traditionally, is to the free choice by the authors. The Power Point Presentations and/or Poster inscriptions should be prepared in English.

**ABSTRACTS** form: (1) Section Number; (2) Authors' degrees and titles, their names and family names; (3) their institution(s) and postal address(es); (4) the phone number and e-mail address of the corresponding author; (5) the abstract title, brief and comprehensive; (6) the abstract body up to 300 words, specifying the field, the statements, and the highlights of research; (7) one-two references (op-

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tional). The abstract originals are expected in English. Optional translations to Polish, Lithuanian or other language selected by the authors can be submitted along with the original. The file name should be composed of the (first') author's name, the word „abstract”, and the abbreviated name of the Conference, e.g., *Smith\_abstract\_20icsql*. Export the Word format file to PDF format and submit **both** the file versions by e-mail [20icsql@uspv.lt](mailto:20icsql@uspv.lt) before 31. of May.

**PROCEEDINGS:** The articles presented at the Conference/Symposium, after peer-reviewing, are to be printed in the series of *Studium Vilnense A* (vol 14), ISSN 1648-7907 or in the *Rocznik SNPL* (Annals of the Association of Polish Scientists of Lithuania) ISSN 1822-3915. The article size should be about 25 000 characters with spaces, including the English abstract, key words, UDC (<http://www.udcc.org/udcsummary/php/index.php?lang=en>) or other classification numbers, the main text with equations, tables, illustrations (graphs and photos), and references. An illustration is equivalent to ~ 1000 characters with spaces. The illustration width should not exceed 8 cm with the symbols clearly readable. Graphs should be black&white.

**References** should be shown in square brackets [1], [2], etc., in ascending order, and listed at the paper end. Reference format **for the articles in journals:** Family name and Name (or initials) of the first author, name(s) or initial(s) and family name(s) of the other authors. Year. „Article title”. *Journal title*, Volume number (Issue number): pages from-to; **in the case of books:** Family name and Name (or initials) of the first author, name(s) or initial(s) and family name(s) of the other authors. Year. Book title, volume number. City: Editorial office.

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**PRESENTATIONS:** Oral presentations shall take 15 min., including questions. A computer with Microsoft Office and a multimedia projector, as well as a whiteboard will be available at the lecture halls. Poster presentations shall take place in the Domus Maria gallery; a single poster width is expected to be *ca* 1 m, and its height *ca* 1,5 m or less.
